## East Cleveland Klondike Bike Race 2019

This years East Cleveland Klondike Bike Race takes place on Sunday, 14th April. The route is just under 100 miles, with the start and finish being at Westgate, Guisborough where the riders, police and team cars will head out onto track, this year, the Klondike is re-designed to incorporate Dunsdale and New Marske before entering onto course at Four Lane Ends. Here the riders will start a figure of eight through the villages of East Cleveland. The Ladies race will depart from the Market Place at 9:00. The Gents race will depart the Market Place at 13:30. As in previous years there will be rolling road closures implemented and managed by Community Traffic Management and the Police. The rolling closure will mean traffic will be stopped for around 15 minutes to allow the 'bubble' to pass through safely. Inevitably, this will cause minor disruption so route planning is required getting to service and home.
